

Dr. Kostuik was previously the Chief of Spine Surgery at The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. He has also served as President of the Scoliosis Research Society and the North American Spine Society, in which he was an original member and organizer. A prolific researcher and author, Dr. Kostuik has composed hundreds of peer-reviewed and invited publications.

Dr. Kostuik has been keynote speaker at almost every major spine society in the world and has trained over 150 internal spine fellows, of which an estimated 145 are in active practice today. In 2010, Dr. Kostuik received the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Scoliosis Research Society.
